



LEAD-IN DEVOTIONAL READING:

God Keeps His Promises

During His final days on earth, Jesus told His disciples what was to come:

“All the nations of the earth... will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky, with power and great glory. And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.”
(Matthew 24:30-31, NIV)

Every year Advent and Christmas shout this truth:
