TOPICS: Praise & Worship; Serving in Christ's Name

LEAD-IN: *You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. (Mark 10:42-52, NIV)*

LEAD-IN DEVOTIONAL READING:

Little Things for God

Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Colossians 3:17, NIV)

We search and trouble ourselves to learn how to love God. Yet it is so simple. It is not necessary to do great things for God. We can do little things for Him.

Do you have small, menial tasks to do? Are they sometimes unpleasant? Do them for love of God, as a personal service to Him. As you work, look to God. Talk to Him. Ask for His help. Then when you complete the task, thank God for the grace to work.

Don't tire of doing little things out of love for Him. The littleness of the work does not lessen the value of the offering, for God regards not the greatness of the work, but the love that prompts it.
