



God's Living Word

But God's word is more than

printed words,

God personally speaks His word.

He does not abandon us to our

weakness and

ignorance.

He speaks His word

within our hearts and minds

by His own Spirit:

"I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear them at the present time. But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take from Mine and will disclose it to you." (John 16:12-14, NASB)

But God goes even further.
He shows us His truth in
 Jesus Christ.
In Christ His truth comes to life.
We see it lived out in Him.
Jesus Christ IS
 the Word of God. (John 1:1-3, 14)

So when you read God's word,
 ask for His Spirit to speak it within you.
