LEAD-IN: *Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, as He already existed in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but emptied Himself by taking the form of a bond-servant and being born in the likeness of men. Humble in Christ

When you look at the human Jesus and

But God lovingly devotes His magnificent self to
ministering to us and to our needs.
Trace the daily life of Jesus, and

called to display?
We shine with God's glory when
we serve human need.

Be eager, be joyful
to spend and be spent in His service.
Feel honored to show people the glorious,
