In You all the fullness of God dwells in bodily form, and in You, we are now complete (Colossians 2:9-10).
Just as You are like Him in every way, we are becoming like Him.
You are growing us to fully share His purpose, His complete self-giving, His love, His holiness, His joy, His deep well-being, and His eternal glory.
All this is ours because You became human.
You emptied Yourself so that we might be forever full in You.

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
