

Jesus Provides Forgiveness

Read Hebrews 9:11-14, 24-28; 10:11-14, 19-23

Jesus not only taught forgiveness, granted forgiveness, and modeled forgiveness. He sacrificed Himself to provide our forgiveness.

Read today's scriptures and rejoice in the truth about your forgiveness:

- Your forgiveness is total. All the evil you have ever done, all that you have ever been, is forgiven completely because of the perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
- Your forgiveness is final and eternal. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ is once-for-all, and it is complete. God has forgotten those sins forever.
- Because of Christ, you can have a clean conscience, no matter what you have done in the past. You come before your Holy Father in perfect confidence, joyfully and unafraid.

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen. (Jude 24-25, NASB)

- Your forgiveness is not just a negative - the removal of guilt - but a positive. Christ makes you holy as He is holy, creating peace with God.
Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God. (Romans 5:1-2, NASB)
