John 14:1-28

What moves me most in John 14 is the

warm,
joyful,
deeply heartfelt way

Jesus continually points us to His Father.

For example:

- Jesus is only leaving His disciples in order to prepare an eternal home for them with His Father and Himself (vv.1-3).
They will all live together forever!
- Jesus' driving purpose is to show them the Father and bring them to the Father (vv.4-10).
- Jesus' words and His works point unmistakably to the Father.
And we ourselves now
speak those words and
do those works ourselves (vv.10-14).
We share in the work they share.
- Jesus is going away only to bless us more abundantly with the Father.
The Father's own Spirit will make His home in us (vv.15-26).

In v.6, Jesus puts it this way:

- I am the way to the Father.
- I am the whole truth about the Father.
- I am the abundant life of the Father.

What a wonderful gift is

Jesus Christ!

And Jesus' greatest blessing to us is

His relationship with the Father.
