## Reflection on Psalm 58

It's easy to desire justice  
as long as the change needs to happen  
    "out there" somewhere or  
    at least in someone else.  
But the judge of all the earth wants  
    His justice,  
    His "rightness"  
to permeate,  
    not just every society,  
but  
    every person,  
    every life,  
    every heart.  
His insatiable yearning for justice

He taught that corruption starts,

    not in societal structures,
